1. Call to Order at 12:30pm

- 2. Comment/Community Updates: <u>Jose Reynoso</u> with the CACC spoke of the interest of the organization in perusing the Specific Plan. The CACC will take a vote of whether the organization will be perusing the Specific Plan at next month's meeting. <u>Jon Dubensky</u> from 2pointDigital introduced his business to the board. The focus of the company is providing affordable digital marketing to businesses. <u>Arnie Gracie</u> from SDG&E announced that SDG&E's commercial rebate program has ended due to its popularity. SDG&E plans on bringing the program back in January when funds return to support it. Arnie also shared the various workshops soon to take place at SDG&E's innovation center, inviting everyone in attendance to come.
